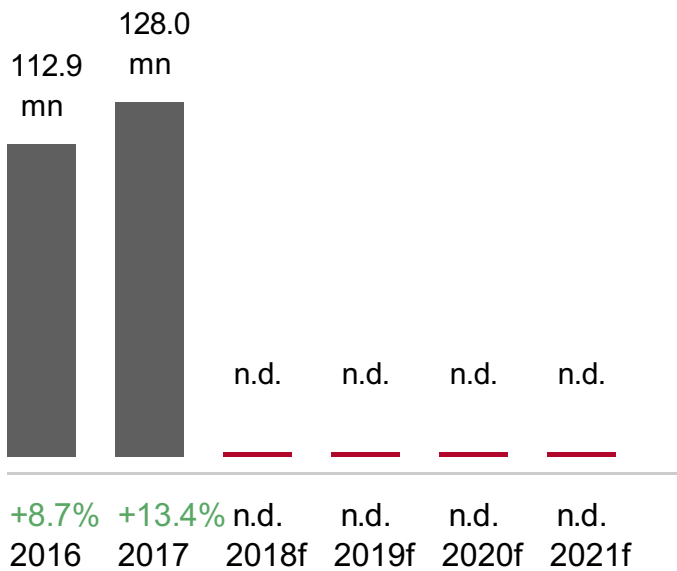

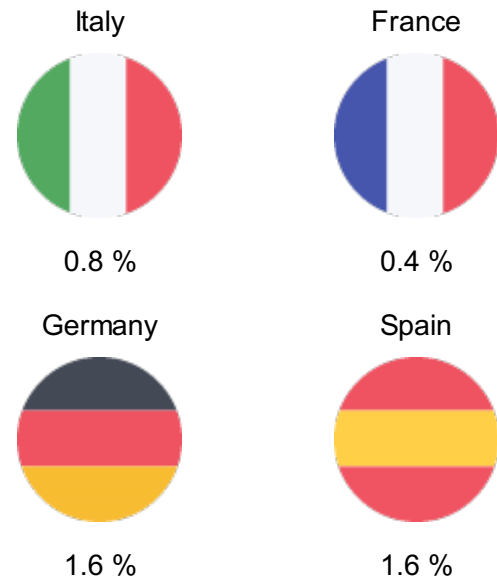
Potential increase in Italian exports by 2021 (€)

Export market shares of Italy and its peers

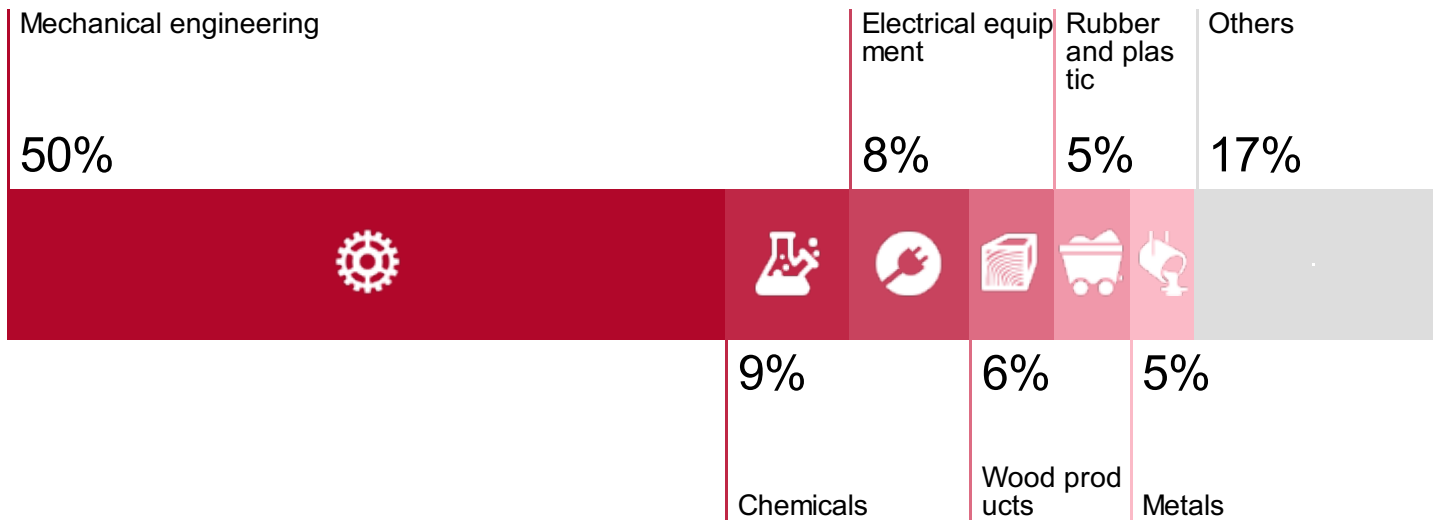
